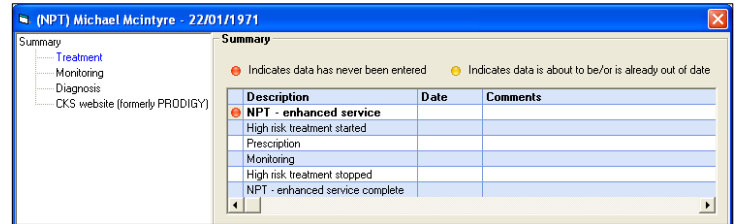


## NHS Forth Valley – Near Patient Testing

The summary screen shows the [data required for this enhanced service](#), and the coloured indicators will highlight any required data. The red indicator shows the patient is not included in the enhanced service claim.

'High risk treatment started' and 'Prescription' will only display the [most recently recorded drug](#), not a full listing even if the patient is on multiple drugs.

The text highlighted in blue on the [treatment screen](#) tells what data is required, and the blue 'P' on a yellow background indicates [data required for payment](#).

'Near patient testing enhanced service commenced' [only has to be recorded once](#) (when commencing the first high risk treatment) to include the patient in the enhanced service claims, [even if the patient is on multiple drugs](#).

**Please note:** The summary grid only shows historical data, and the indicators shown here will reflect the status when entering the consultation.

The [data required for payment](#) is marked with the red indicators. You must record:

- [NPT – enhanced service](#) commenced
- The name of the [high risk treatment started](#)
- [Prescription during the last 3 months](#) unless the patient is being prescribed **Auranofin**, **Cyclophosphamide**, **Methotrexate** or **Sodium Aurothiomalate**, as they are only required annually
- [Monitoring during the last 6 months](#), with exception of **Amiodarone** which is required annually.

The 3 drug categories under High risk treatment started are [anti-arrhythmic](#), [atypical antipsychotic](#) or [immunosuppressant](#). If the drug name does not appear in any of those categories it should be recorded as 'Other' with the name of the drug specified in the text box.

The name of the selected drug will be entered into the text extension of the high risk treatment started read code.

When [stopping a treatment](#), the drug must be removed in the same way it was entered, using the treatment stopped section at the bottom of the screen.

Monitoring should be recorded during the [last 6 months](#), with exception of **Amiodarone** which is required annually. A record of any of these samples sent to lab, or appropriate results entered through SPICE will be accepted for payment.

Points to note:

- If a patient is on multiple drugs you should record the name of each high risk treatment started as and when it's prescribed.
- Appropriate monitoring and a prescription should also be recorded for each drug.
- If the patient comes off one of the prescribed drugs, again the name of the drug should be recorded in the treatment stopped section.
- 'Enhanced service completed' should not be recorded at this point unless the patient has come off all the prescribed near patient testing drugs.
